CREED CONTEST Each school will be allowed to enter up to four participants. They can all be in the same division. **Applications must be received, not postmarked, by October 12, 2010.**

NAME TAG All delegates must wear a name tag (stick-on are OK). The name tag contest is optional.

P.R. The Executive Council Officers suggest that you use your poster and name tag for P. R. before and/or after taking it to Fall Rally.

WORK-SHOPS- We will have a variety of activities to encourage teamwork between chapters and within chapters. Some of the workshops will be based on FCCLA facts so your members might want to look over some general information before they arrive. We will also be having an officer training this year. To help us with the planning we are asking for each chapter to let us know

how many members you will be having attend the training. We will have two sessions so that the groups will not be as large.

FALL RALLY CONTESTS

2010 CONTESTS: Name Tag, Poster, Membership, and Creed.

RULES: See the Fall Rally section in the handbook pages 10 – 15. You will find this on NH FCCLA website under chapter handbook. The section has been undated so make sure you check all the rules. The forms have been adjusted so they can be filled in on the computer.

AWARDS: For the poster and name tag contest, each chapter will need to identify no more than 5 members to be recognized but only one to go to the stage to receive the ribbon and certificate.

REMINDERS

NAME TAG: Chapters can enter **only one name tag per chapter** not per level. In addition to being a contest, the name tags are used as a way to identify the members; everyone must wear their name tag at all times at the conference. **Chapters will need to submit 2 name tags with their application; we will use one for judging and one to make a display board. Name tags can not be larger than 6” x 6”. The strap for wearing it around your neck does not count as part of the measurements.**

MEMBERSHIP: Vouchers for discounts for Spring Conference.

MEALS

We will not have any meals available. Each chapter is responsible for bringing their own. This could be a fun time to bring some blankets and have a picnic. Tables are available in the hall for those who choose to use them.
