Each truck will have 400 prepackaged boxes of food, 400 boxes of personal care and hygiene items and two pallets of miscellaneous goods for impoverished families. One box of food feeds a family of four for one week.

We are asking each chapter to write letters to local businesses to contribute \$10.00 toward our goal of raising \$7,200.
